## REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO LAND PASSENGERS

According to Danish law, ships who carries more than 12 passengers, are classified as passenger vessels, and thereby has to follow the same regulations as cruise ships. This meaning that they have to get permission by the Danish Ministry of Interior to land passengers in any Danish port.

This includes private yachts and all other ships, including Sailing School Ships, which is not run by Government/Merchant Navy organizations. All other crewmembers than the regular crew is here considered passengers, even if they are doing work onboard as crewmembers or are under education.

For all ships that carry more than 12 passengers a request for PERMISSION TO LAND PASSENGERS therefore has to be made for each planned port of arrival in Denmark. For arrivals to Copenhagen, an application form has been made for that use. Please fill in the form, and send it to:

Please note, that the request has to be send at least a month prior to your planned arrival. You will then later receive the permission from the Danish Ministry of Interior, in which specifications of the terms and conditions on which the "permission to land passengers" has been given. The permission will be valid for one year, and will have to be renewed every year.
