4. A BETTER CONNNECTIVITY

An urban strategy that together with the Climate Ribbon strengthens the physical and mental connections between the city, nature, water and the local guarters. The layout orients the city's development both along and across the river, thus restoring water and nature as the vital focal point of the city.

5. SHARED SPACES

An urban and social concept that creates three strategically placed urban spaces which link the city to the water. Three urban and landscape spaces, such as the Bolværket and Flodlejet, that aim to engage and involve all citizens of Randers as a vital part of the city's development and ensure that the city's blue and green resources are shared in everyday life.

6. DIVERSITY IN BUILDINGS - ROBUSTNESS IN DEVELOPING

An architectural approach that builds on Rander's tradition for smaller and characteristic neighbourhoods, by developing new neighbourhoods with clear architectural identities and qualities. The plots vary in size and character, ensuring a diverse mix of buildings and a robustness in long-term development. This gives way to ordinary families' day-to-day dreams, as well as options for visionary and experimental urban developments that set a new direction for Randers.
