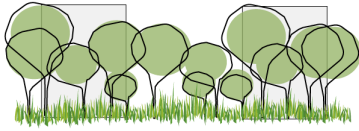


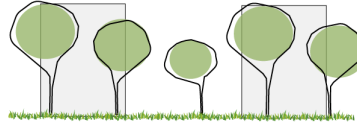
LANDSCAPE STRATEGY

ARRIVING AT DEP. 19 & 22 BEFORE



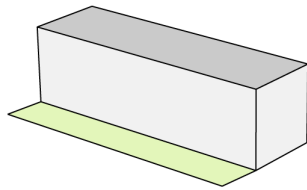
The buildings were tucked away and identity of the area was undefined.

ARRIVING AT DEP. 19 & 22 NOW



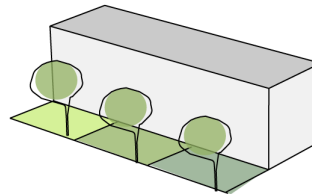
Greater insight into the settlement - The buildings themselves create the identity.

ARRIVING AT YOUR HOME BEFORE



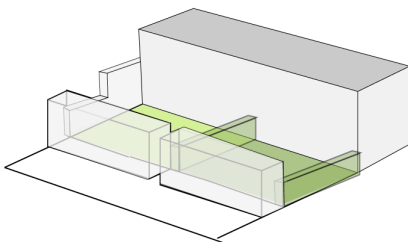
The area in front of the residence was common and nobody felt any ownership. The straight course emphasized the building's monotony.

ARRIVING AT YOUR HOME NOW



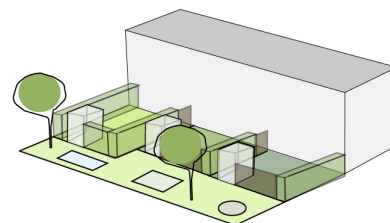
Visually the building is divided by giving the front gardens individual planting and the area gets a townhouse character. Ownership and identity feeling is increased among the residents.

GARDENS BEFORE



The gardens were fronted by sheds and enclosed by hedges. Both increased the monotony of the streetscape

GARDENS NOW



The gardens are bordered by alternating fences and lower hedge-planting. The length varies, creating space in the semi-public zone along the residence street.
